ANZAMEMS Early Career Fellowship Program 2022 Application Form

(Last updated 1 November 2021)

The ANZAMEMS Early Career Fellowship Program is intended to support the development of early career researchers in pursuing advanced research and publication in medieval studies, early modern studies, and medievalism. Applicants should make a strong case for their proposed topic's importance, its relevance to a field of study relevant to ANZAMEMS, and the originality and sophistication of its approach.

Entry is open to:

- a) **Postgraduate Students** formally enrolled in a PhD by research programme or equivalent at an HE institution in Australia or Aotearoa New Zealand, whose thesis has been submitted but may be under examination at the time of the application for the Award. Requests for exceptions will require strong support from the Senior Supervisor.
- OR
- b) **Early Careers Researchers** with a connection to Australia or Aotearoa New Zealand;
- OR
- c). **Independent scholars** with a connection to Australia or Aotearoa New Zealand.

To enter, please email a completed Application Form, along with the documentation listed below to info@anzamems.org by **5:00pm (AWST), 14 January 2021**:

- 1,500-word project description;
- An up-to-date CV (of no more than 2 pages);
- One (1) letter of recommendation;
- For applicants who do not yet have the PhD in hand, one (1) additional letter of recommendation from your primary supervisor indicating expected date of completion is required;
- A statement regarding career interruptions, if requested to do so at Q5 below;
- All documents must be submitted in English.
