

Philippa Maddern ECR Publication Prize

Conditions of entry:

Eligibility

Entry is open to **Early Career Researchers** within 10 years of the award of a PhD (or equivalent research degree).

An extension to the 10-year limit may be granted for significant career interruption/s due to any one or more of the following circumstances:

- Carer responsibilities.
- International relocation for post- doctoral or other research employment.
- Serious illness.
- Maternity or parental leave.
- Unemployment.
- Employment outside academia/current academic discipline.

Please note: To be eligible for the Maddern Prize, you should be / have been:

- A current financial member of ANZAMEMS.
- An Early Career Researcher at the date of the publication of your work.
- A Citizen or Permanent Resident of Australia or New Zealand.

Only one submission per entrant will be accepted.

Determination of eligibility will be at the discretion of the ANZAMEMS Honours and Prizes Sub-Committee.

To be considered for the Maddern Prize, the Publication must:

- Be the work of a single author.
- Be between 5000 and 8000 words in length.
- Appear in a peer-reviewed journal or an edited collection.
- Have been published in the period 1 December 2021–31 August 2023. *NB: early online publication of articles will also be considered. The article must have been published online before the above cut-off date.*
- Be based upon original research.

Prize Details

- Winners will receive \$1000 AUD in prize money (or NZD equivalent).
- The winner will be announced at the next ANZAMEMS Conference and publicized in the next convenient issue of *Parergon* and the ANZAMEMS Newsletter.

Judging Details

The Judging Panel will consist of:

- The ANZAMEMS President; the ANZAMEMS Vice-President (Australia); another member of the ANZAMEMS Committee; and a representative, selected by the Committee, of the general membership of ANZAMEMS.
- The Judging Panel reserves the right not to award a Prize in the event that insufficient entries are received, or for any other reason.
- The Judging Panel's decision will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
