ANZAMEMS Conference Bursaries

Conditions of Entry:

Eligibility

To be eligible, applicants must be:

- A current financial member of the Association;

AND

- A Postgraduate Student;

OR

- An Early Career Researcher.

Postgraduate Students should be enrolled in higher degree research programs (MA by research or PhD) at the time of their application.

Early Career Researchers should have graduated from a higher degree research program (MA by research or PhD) within the last five years and should not yet be employed in an ongoing academic position.

Application Process

The application process, which will be left to the discretion of the ANZAMEMS Honours and Prizes Sub-Committee and will be advertised at the same time as the Conference's Call for Papers. It is likely to require submission of:

- Contact details.
- Title and abstract of paper to be presented at the conference.

- Proof of enrolment or recent award.
- A budget/quotes outlining cost of attendance at conference.
- Name of institution and supervisor.

Judging Details:

- The bursary applicants will be judged by a panel selected by the chair of ANZAMEMS Honours and Prizes sub-committee.
- It is not expected that ANZAMEMS be able to offer a bursary to every eligible applicant. In the event of there being more eligible applicants than can be supported, the ANZAMEMS Honours and Prizes sub-committee will rank applicants according to distance travelled, financial need, current employment status, and access to other sources of funding.

Prize Details

- Administration of the bursaries, including arranging payment with the Treasurer, is the responsibility of the ANZAMEMS Honours and Prizes sub-committee.
- Payment of the bursaries (i.e., funds) is the responsibility of the Treasurer.
