

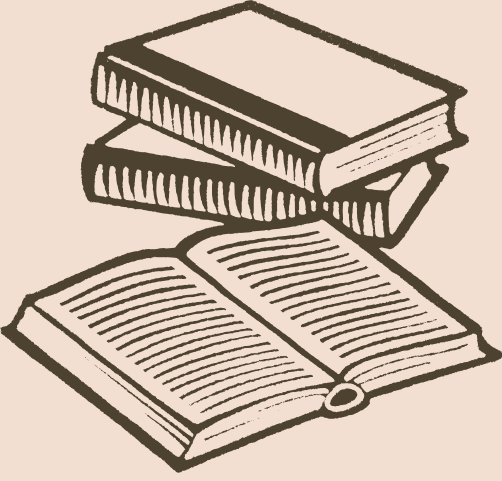

# Humanities Horizons Postgrad Conference 2024

How can we, as the next generation of humanities scholars, continue to craft rich analyses of the human condition and experience by building on those who have come before but - excitingly - push towards new horizons for contemporary and future audiences?

**Humanities Horizons** aims for open and multifaceted explorations of contemporary approaches to research and furthering the humanities in 2024.

We invite honours, postgraduate research students, and recently graduated scholars from the humanities and adjacent disciplines to come together to share their work, socialise and, in a world where the humanities appear to be increasingly under threat, to acknowledge the inherent value of their research.

We welcome papers from a broad definition of the humanities, including:

- **Archaeology, Classics, and Ancient History**
- **Gender and Cultural Studies**
- **Linguistics**
- **Philosophy**
- **Anthropology**
- **Sociology**
- **Indigenous Studies**

Papers should be suitable for a 20-minute session, with additional time for audience questions.
